PROGRAM**

Major goals of the ISA Olympic Development Program (ODP) are to provide the best soccer players in Iowa the opportunity to improve their level of play through high level training, to give these athletes a chance to compete with other talented players at higher levels of competition and to provide them with the opportunity to showcase their talent for college coaches. Keep in mind that these are our own state level goals and that the major purpose of ODP events on a regional and national level is to identify players for our U.S. National Teams.

ODP is not meant to replace club teams. We do our best to work with ISA affiliate clubs to coordinate ODP and club soccer events to minimize conflicts. However, it is impossible to avoid all conflicts. To have a quality ODP program we must schedule ODP events throughout the year.

- If you cannot attend any of the tryouts listed, please contact the ISA State Director of Coaching (in writing) identifying the conflict. In certain circumstances players can be added to the ISA scouting program.
- 98/99 Girls & Boys-Two teams will be formed in the 98/99 boys' and girls' birth years. One team will be made up of players born in the older half of the birth year, Jan. 1-June 30 and a second team in the younger half of the birth year, July 1-Dec. 31 including 99 birth year players.
- 1994 & 1995 BODP Tryouts will be held in 2011.

Players are evaluated and selected based on four basic components that make a talented soccer player.

- **Technique**
- **Tactical sense or decision making ability**
- **Fitness and athletic ability**
- **Attitude**

PARTICIPATION

Upon selection, an Iowa ODP player is expected to participate in all activities of their pool and team. These activities may include training sessions, exhibition matches, invitational tournaments and regional camps. If players are not available for a specific event, another player from their pool or team may replace them.

Players are expected to take their participation seriously, and should be committed to improving their individual skills as well as improving as a team player. Players are subject to the ODP *Code of Conduct* upon entry into the program.
