IRC 4th Quarterly Report

November 2, 2009

1. We are sending 8 referees and one assessor to the Developmental Academy games being held in Phoenix AZ from December 3rd to the 8th.
2. We supported the State Cup games with assessors for each game each weekend. The Referees were given developmental assessments at no cost to them. The feed back was well received and improvements were made by the referees from one game to the next.
3. We have approved our budget for the next fiscal year and supplied a copy to the ISA.
4. Shane Smith was appointed as the new SDA replacing Jim Albertson. Jim resigned the position to concentrate on his duties as the ISA President and as the IRC Registrar. Shane will be going over the list of assessors and contacting the less active ones to have them do more assessments and attend clinics.
5. Landis Wiley has redesigned and updated the IRC web site to make it more user friendly. We still have the same web site address of www.Iowareferees.org.
6. We hosted an in-service clinic for all existing assessors in Iowa on October 3rd.
7. The annual Referee Academy will be held in the Des Moines area in March 2010. The MISOA organization will be coordinating all of the details for this event.
8. The Latino leagues are trying hard to get the referees that they use for their games upgraded to the next level. After several assessments have been completed some of the Latino referees have been found to be quite capable and have been asked to join the local referee organizations so that they can get better quality games to work with to go farther up the ladder as referees.
9. We have one more referee that has declared himself as a National Candidate and will be working towards that goal for the next two years.
10. Katja Koroleva has been invited to attend the D 2 Women's Championships as a referee. She had to turn down the opportunity due to her class schedule in School.
11. Registrations for the 2010 year are well underway and the first batch of referee registrations has been sent in to Chicago. Registration fees have remained the same as last year.
