Notes

- All State Referee Association requirements **must be made public**
- In order to successfully complete the course, candidates must demonstrate comprehensive knowledge of the subject matter and display effective practical skills as evaluated and determined by the course instructor(s) assigned by the State Referee Association
- All training requirements can be completed on-line and/or in the classroom setting as determined by the State Referee Association and there are no minimum number of hours associated with either requirement
- The minimum passing test score is 80% and all testing requirements can be completed on-line and/or in the classroom setting as determined by the State Referee Association
- State Referee Associations may establish additional requirements related to the number of development/guidance evaluations to be completed annually
