Previous Game Experience	50 Games as a Referee and 25 as an Assistant Referee at Local Adult Amateur Level
Previous Certification	Minimum of Three (3) Consecutive Years as a Grassroots Referee
Training	Regional Referee Course and On-field Experience
Safety and Compliance	SafeSport Trained, Safe Soccer Training, and Background Check
Laws of the Game Quiz	On-line - Regional Quiz
Fitness Test	Sprint/Interval Test (FIFA Women's Referee Test) Male - Category 1 / Female - Category 3
Practical Evaluation	Minimum of 3 Passing Evaluations as a Referee 2 at Adult Amateur Level & 1 at Highest Youth (U18 or U19) - 2 x 45 minute half Evaluations Must Be Done by 3 Different Referee Coaches
