

SECTION I: PRACTICE

Indoor practice is currently sanctioned by the State Association providing the sponsoring Organization Member is in compliance with Section V below.

SECTION II: ORGANIZED GAMES

 Organized games are defined as a structured group of four (4) or more teams joined for the purpose of interplay under a common set of administrative and competition rules.
Requirements include: all players and coaches must be members of the lowa Soccer Association and all referees must be USSF certified.

SECTION III: TOURNAMENTS

Indoor tournaments may be sanctioned and are subject to all rules and policies as defined in the Application to Host.

SECTION IV: APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR GAMES AND TOURNAMENTS

- 1. The club must complete an Application to Host in order to host games and tournaments. The Application to Host is found online at www.thetournamentcenter.com.
- 2. The club will be invoiced a \$50 administrative fee for an approved application.

SECTION V: ON SITE ADMINISTRATION FOR INDOOR GAMES AND TOURNAMENTS

- 1. An officer of the club must make a pre-application inspection of the facility(ies) using ISA checklists found on the ISA website.
- 2. A representative of the club must inspect the facility prior to each scheduled day of matches.
- 3. A representative of the club must be on site at each facility during match times.
- 4. Any irregularities with the facilities, matches or unusual incidences occurring during play must be reported to the State Association as soon as possible.
- 5. A post tournament report found on the tournament center.com website must be forwarded to the State Association no more than thirty (30) days after the last scheduled matches. The report should include incidences occurring during the scheduled games and/or tournament.

Failure to comply with the above will nullify both medical and liability insurance coverage and the club will be subject to further action as per our bylaws.
