



When sharing a concern, it is important to communicate in the proper sequence and with the correct individuals and/or organizations. To facilitate a productive process, it is also essential to communicate respectfully, professionally and factually. Communications should always refrain from attacks on the individual(s) and/or the organization(s) involved.

In communicating a concern, follow these steps in order, moving on to the next step only if necessary:

**STEP ONE:** Contact your Club Board President and if necessary, your club Executive or

Technical leader, with your concern

**STEP TWO:** Contact the appropriate Iowa Soccer staff member\* with your concern

**STEP THREE:** Contact the Iowa Soccer Executive Director\* with your concern

**STEP FOUR:** Request\* contact with the Iowa Soccer Board of Directors Chairperson

## When stating your concern, include the following:

- State why you are requesting the individual and/or organization review your concern
- Respectfully state your concern and the relevant facts
- Include insight, facts and perspective that are yours and/or your club's
- Refrain from representing thoughts or intentions of an outside person, group, organization or club
- If necessary, provide documentation of facts needed to support your request to review
