This is a guide to the levels of games to which a referee can be assigned.	
How to use this information	
Referees	
You should work the highest level of game that you can.	
When assignments are made for the same level of game, the referee will work the game that was assigned first.	
Share your referee goals with your assigners so that the assigners can work with you to make assignments that will enhance your career path.	
Assignors	
Work together to make sure that the highest level game has the most appropriate referees.	
Be ready to release referees that call to request a release in order to work a higher level game.	
How it works (example)	
If a referee has accepted an assignment for a competitive youth game and an assignment arrives for a Division Three College game, the referee should refer to the sheet and see that the college game is a higher level game than the youth game. The referee should work the college game.	
The referee will contact the assignor for the college game to explain the situation, then contact the assigner for the youth game to request being released from the that game. According to the Game Hierarchy, the assignor of the youth game will release the referee from that assignment so that the referee can accept the assignment at the higher level.
